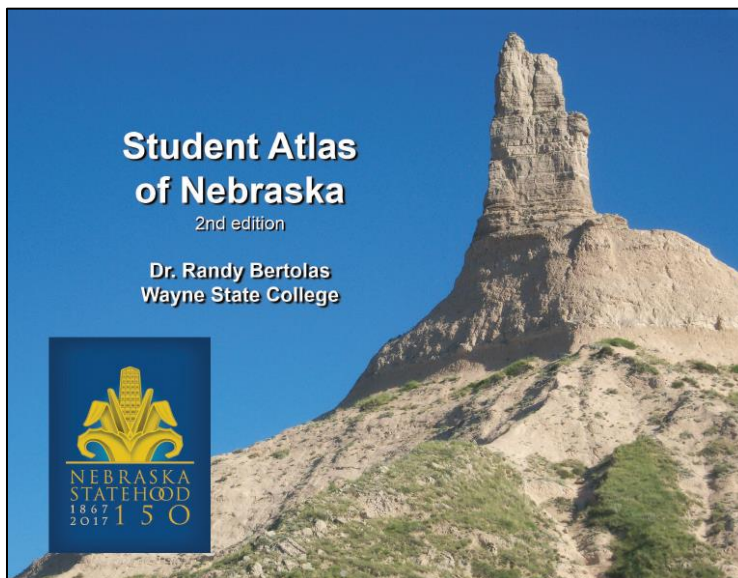


The Geographic Educators of Nebraska present



2018 “STUDENT ATLAS OF NEBRASKA” WORKSHOPS

The Geographic Educators of Nebraska will offer free training in using the *Student Atlas of Nebraska* from 9:00-3:00 on the dates/locations listed below. Lunch will also be provided free of charge during the workshop. The *Student Atlas of Nebraska* is geared toward 4th grade reading levels and is filled with maps, tables, and pictures to aid instruction in Nebraska Studies. Teachers contracted for 4th grade during the 2018-19 school year are eligible to enroll in one of these GEON workshops.

A cap of twenty teachers in each workshop is preferred, minimum 4 teachers required for workshop to proceed. Each teacher attending the full workshop day will be provided with a \$100 stipend as well as free curriculum materials on a flash drive including standards-based lesson plans, Atlas PDFs, and a Teacher’s Guide to the Atlas. Last fall, classroom copies of the *Student Atlas of Nebraska* were made available to all 4th grade teachers throughout the state via their local ESU office.
