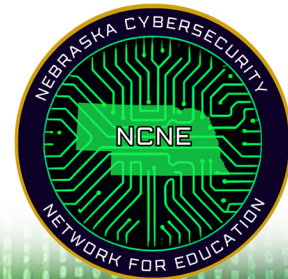


# Protect Your School Top 12 Tasks for Cybersecurity



## Do NOT use an admin account for daily use



If an admin account is compromised, a situation can go from bad to worse very quickly

## Use Multi Factor Authentication



While MFA is recommended on email, also use it for other types of accounts and devices

## Use Password Manager & Avoid Password Reuse



Every account needs a unique password. The use of a password manager simplifies this task

## Network Segmentation



Proper network segmentation allows for more efficient operation and can prevent lateral movement

## Keep Work and Personal Passwords Separate



Keeping work and personal passwords separate protects both your work and home lives from cross-contamination

## Off-Site Immutable Backups



Off-site backups protect from on-site disasters. But they need to be tested frequently and checked daily

## EDR



Have EDR deployed on all machines, active and enabled. Non-protected machines can compromise even protected machines

## Vulnerability Patches



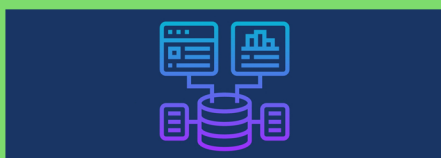
Keep all endpoints, network devices and appliances with current patches by automated methods

## Inventory Management

## Centralized Logging



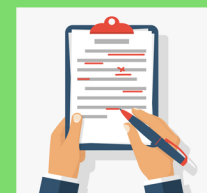
Centralizing logs from across the organization can create a complete picture pre- and post-incident
