John Baylor - OnToCollege Presentation:

Highlights: OnToCollege helps families and schools create two-and four-year college graduates with minimal debt by helping families and schools with ACT, PreACT, and SAT/PSAT prep coupled with college counseling. They utilize a unique motivation in explaining the "why to try" to develop skills that cannot be automated or sourced out.

Implementation is the key to success. There are some middle school sessions available.

- 9th grade ASPIRE Prep gives students early exposure to test
- 10th grade PreACT Prep for sophmores, or more practice
- 11th grade PSAT Prep for National Merit Scholars and Act Prep fro All Juniors for the state test in April
- 12th grade ACT Refresher course for all Seniors.
